







If you missed the banquet, you missed a really good time. I will try to give a quick accounting of who got what. Certificates are awarded for riders when they have earned 50, 150, and 300 points. The 500 point riders receive a patch and are eligible to buy the NACMO jacket to put their patch on. 1000 point riders receive a directors chair suitably imprinted so we can pick them out at the campfires.

When a horse has accumulated 800 points, an imprinted stable sheet is awarded. Sara and Larry Dick's horses, Zima and Molly received their blankets this year.

Our Rookies of the year were Teresa Serry and Patricia Richerson who received imprinted tack bags.

Junior riders Jessica Reed and runner up Izzy Rash for IL got received imprinted long sleeved shirts.

Evan Crooks and runner up Greg Griffiths for IN got imprinted denim shirts.

Ride manager awards were numerous this year. All members who managed a ride this past season were awarded \$50 gift certificates from NACMO to help with gas and other expenses involved in setting up and managing a ride.

Mary Gorman and Bruce DeVries, who have cumulatively managed 15 rides, received stable blankets for their horses.

Members who have managed more than 25 rides are being awarded at each 5 ride interval. Since no one item could be agreed upon throughout NACMO, we each took the \$20 allocated and awarded each other. Pat Mouw, having managed 32 rides, bought a gift for Jeanie Richardson, who has managed 37 rides. Jeanie bought a gift for Dave Caldwell at 45 rides, who gifted Robin who has also managed 45 rides. Robin bought a gift for Marti Caldwell at 66 rides, who bought Pat's gift. We all agreed that was much more fun than gift certificates!

There are awards for RMs when they have managed 5, 10 and 20 rides, as well as horses who have attained 1000 and 1500 points, but we had no one new in those categories this year.

High point IL team were the Boonie Wampin Yee Ha Chicks, Jamie, Cary and Jessica Reed and Denise Bingamon. IN High point team were the Babes of the Woods, Sara and Larry Dick, Dave and Marti Caldwell and Jeanie Richardson. They received peel and stick vinyl signs to adorn their trailers.

The state High point teams are determined by NACMO by their best 5 rides in the season. From the various state champions, NACMO awards a National Champion, which is based on their best 5 rides and also the number of competitors at those best 5 rides. Our own Boonie Wampin Yee Ha Chicks received this coveted award - imprinted shirts - with a perfect score of 80 points (5 wins) plus a "comp" score of 142. The Babes were 2nd in the nation with 80 points and a comp score of 137. The next two teams nationally (from WA and MI also had 80 points and comp scores of 95 and 89, which shows how well attended the rides in IN/IL were in 2010! All of us should be proud of that since it was our members who combined to produce those high competitor numbers!

Our organization also awards our top teams based on overall season total points, not just best 5 rides. Our top 6 teams, were:

**Interested in having a Mentor at your first CMO?**

If you would like to ride with an experienced CMO'er for your first ride, please contact the ride manager in advance, they will attempt to match you with someone who fits your riding speed.

Friday rides - Riders may start after 12:00pm. Saturday rides - Riders may start as early as 8:00am, and are encouraged to start by 1:00pm. Sunday rides - Riders MUST start before 12:00pm on Sunday. Unless otherwise stated. Check with the ride manager to verify time, date, and place ahead of time (remember the ride manager usually camps early to set up, so call early). Potluck each Saturday evening. Long and Short Courses available each day.

All rides are NACMO and MICMO sanctioned. Riders earn lifetime points and a chance at each ride's awards. CMO's are usually \$10 for NACMO annual members, \$15 for day members, \$5 for Junior members or \$10 for Junior day members. You can join NACMO & MICMO at the ride. Horses must be 3 years old to participate. Juniors must have written parental permission and ride with an adult. Participants may ride as an individual or as part of a team of up to 6 riders. Bring an orienteering compass and something to write with, we have some compasses for sale and available to loan.

### “The Thinking Horse Sport”

Competitive Mounted Orienteering (CMO) Competitive Mounted Orienteering is a timed event. The ride manager has set up from 5 to 10 paper plates (called markers) in a given area. You will be given a map with the general area of the markers circled, along with a list of clues to find the marker. The clues will describe something in the area - perhaps a specific tree, a lot, or a shelter, along with a compass reading. Each team then decides their route to each marker, locates the landmarks from the clues, and finds the marker using a compass. Write the letters found on the marker on your map to verify that you were there, then ride on to the next marker. Ride as an individual or a team of two or more. Bring your horse, your compass, and be prepared for a great afternoon of riding. Points are kept on a state level and national level, and year end awards are also given at an annual banquet.
